
Separator toilet conversion kit

If you have one of several common models of Thetford cassette toilets, you might be interested in the ingenious Arwinger conversion kits that turn them into separator (waterless or composting) toilets.

The kits come in three main parts: separate liquid and solid containers, and a seat. The conversion promises to be a DIY job and, once fitted, with the lid down, it looks just like the original.

The containers can be separated for emptying. The solids tank has a capacity of about 9 litres, and uses disposable bags for easy emptying. Meanwhile, the liquid tank, which holds 7.5 litres, is filled via a tube from the bowl and is spill-proof when transported for disposal. An

indicator on the liquids tank shows you when it's nearly full.

The conversion kits are initially available for Thetford C200, C220, C250 and C260 models. Kits for Thetford C2, C3 and C4 toilets are under development, along with the Dometic 4110.

Arwinger is a young German motorhome company, and the kit is a patented invention of the company founder, who noticed many motorhomes and boats have cassette toilets but no easy way to switch over to separating models. His distributor in the UK is VIATS of Redditch, with a current retail price of £995.
